Daniel Robinson One pound of tobacco &c. two hundred thirty  
and nine lbs is by the Court ordered to be

Peter Abbey vs W. Robinson - 200 lbs of tobacco in the  
Abraham Thomas & Isaac Hollisworth - 200 lbs of tobacco  
into the Court custody for want of pay
