And a copy of the said writ being returned with the writ in
 order for an Attachment the said Rich^d. Bannet in his attorney
 prayer of his Majesty's said writ of Attachment may unto him
 be granted for y^e recovery of y^e debt of suit

It is therefore considered by the court this twenty third day
 of March Anno 1702 that the said Richard Bannet recover
 against the said John Jones as well the sum of five thousand seven
 hundred and eighty pounds of tobacco the debt as the sum of
 two hundred and thirty two pounds of tobacco cost of suit to be
 levied upon the goods chattels or credits of the said John Jones by
 way of Attachment according to Act of Assembly etc.
