Sam^l Thomas brings a serf named Sam^l Slight who is
adjudged by this Court to be sixteen years of age And that the
said serf had the duty to serve Saush (part) from his arrival
into this County to Capt: Halbert

In: Synleij / serf to Jaat Bowles is adjudged by this Court
to be thirteen years of age

This Court is adjourned for one hour
The Court mett againe, and Justices present as before

This Court adjournes untill to Morrow at eight of
the Clock
