ells of linen of a price of fifteen shillings two pence of painted Calicoes of a price of two shillings three pence of summer gloves of a price of five shillings one piece of porringers of a price of two shillings & one box lock of a price of one shilling amounting in the whole to the value of two pence one shilling & six pence the said goods & chattels of Edward Scot felonously by the said Elizabeth of a price of our Lady Queen & of the form of an act of assembly in the said month provided that the said

And the said Elizabeth Richey being called to the bar appeared and prayed for all of the premises the Court was being granted the said Elizabeth for the said offence she sayeth that she is not guilty and thereof puts her self for trial upon her country
And the said Richard Macleod who speaks for our Lady of Queen in like manner

Thereupon command is given the Sheriff of Kent Countie that he should cause the said Elizabeth to be taken to the County Gaol and there to remain until she be bailed or until she be committed to the County Gaol
And the said Sheriff of Kent Countie hath accordingly done as by his receipt to the said Court is to be seen

The said Elizabeth being called to the bar and sworn to say the truth in the premises
do say upon their oathes that of the jury having heard the evidence
Guilty of the premises which being by the Court heard & understood
is by them confessed that the Sheriff of Kent Countie immediately take
the said Elizabeth Richey & put her in the Pillory according to
Custom there to remain for the space of one hour and that after
the said one hour is expired she was taken to the Whipping post & given
twenty lashes on her bare back well laid on and that the said Elizabeth
Richey satisfied & pay unto the said Court the sum of eight pence
six shillings for the fine of the goods & that being by the
Court assessed to the same amount and that the said Elizabeth Richey pay
all the charges in this behalf accruing
And the said Court having executed the corporal punishments a
fter the 24th day of June anno domini 1402 the said Elizabeth Richey
was committed into the Sheriff's Custody until such satisfaction
be made of judgement about & given for,
