 Charles Hollinsworth }  
 Command was Given to the Serj of Kent County to take Charles  
 Hollinsworth if to be found in his Bailwick & him Safe Keep  
 to be he have his body before y<sup>e</sup> Justices of our County  
 being y<sup>e</sup> 24<sup>th</sup> day of August 1703 he made his ret. for me John Hawkins Star  
 And y<sup>e</sup> said Deft by Michael Earle his att<sup>y</sup> comes & 10<sup>th</sup> Leave y<sup>e</sup> next  
 Court being the twenty second Day of y<sup>e</sup> 3<sup>rd</sup> year of y<sup>e</sup> said action was con-  
 tinued, and soe continued from Court, to Court until this present Court at y<sup>e</sup> 20<sup>th</sup>  
 present Court being the four & twentieth Day of August anno Dom 1703  
 The said p<sup>l</sup> by Richard Macklin his att<sup>y</sup> comes & Declares as follows

Charles Hollinsworth Jun<sup>r</sup>, of Kent County plant<sup>r</sup> & S<sup>r</sup> stands attached to an-  
 swer unto Flower Walker of a plea of trespass upon y<sup>e</sup> case & thereupon  
 the said Flower Walker by Richard Macklin his attorney complains  
 & whereas y<sup>e</sup> said Flower Walker y<sup>e</sup> second Day of y<sup>e</sup> 3<sup>rd</sup> year anno Dom 1700 & y<sup>e</sup> 20<sup>th</sup>  
 & twentieth day of July and Dom 1701 at Kent County within y<sup>e</sup> Jurisdiction of  
 this Court at Special Instance & request of y<sup>e</sup> said Charles had sold & Delivered  
 unto y<sup>e</sup> said Charles Divers goods Wares & merchandizes amounting to y<sup>e</sup> sum of one  
 thousand eight hundred & ninety nine pounds and all y<sup>e</sup> like Instance  
 & request of y<sup>e</sup> said Charles y<sup>e</sup> four & twentieth Day of July anno Dom 1701 within y<sup>e</sup>  
 Jurisdiction aforesaid had lent unto y<sup>e</sup> said Charles y<sup>e</sup> sum of five shillings Sterl money  
 which in tobe all one penny for pound amounts to y<sup>e</sup> sum of Sixty pounds of tobe  
 all which said Goods Wares & merchandizes sold & Delivered & money lent at one  
 penny for pound in tobe amounts in y<sup>e</sup> whole to y<sup>e</sup> sum of one thousand nine  
 hundred fifty & nine pounds of tobe as by an Act thereof to this Declaration  
 in case & here in Court brought y<sup>e</sup> same appears in Evidence whereof y<sup>e</sup> said  
 Charles upon himselfe admitted & unto y<sup>e</sup> said Flower Walker then & there  
 faithfully promised y<sup>e</sup> he y<sup>e</sup> said Charles when sh<sup>r</sup> counts & sh<sup>r</sup> required  
 y<sup>e</sup> aforesaid sum of 1749 of tobe unto the said Flower Walker he would well &  
 truly content & pay And altho the said Charles hath paid & satisfied  
 unto y<sup>e</sup> said Flower the sum of ~~1749~~ <sup>1749</sup> pounds of tobe  
 of y<sup>e</sup> aforesaid sum of 1749 of tobe yett as to y<sup>e</sup> residue thereof being the sum  
 of eight hundred & fifty pounds of tobe the said Charles his wife & abanption  
 aforesaid little regarding or minding but plotting contriving & fraudulently intend-  
 ing him the said Flower in that behalf <sup>deceitfully & subtilly</sup> to Deceive &  
 Defraud y<sup>e</sup> aforesaid sum of five hundred & Sixty pounds of tobe accord-  
 ing to y<sup>e</sup> said promise & abanption altho the sh<sup>r</sup> counts & sh<sup>r</sup> required unto  
 the said Charles hath not payed but y<sup>e</sup> same to pay he hath Denied & refused &  
 still doth Deny & refuse to y<sup>e</sup> Damage of y<sup>e</sup> said Flower 1700 tobe &  
 thereupon he brings this said Macklin of Blagge Jo<sup>n</sup> Doe Deft
