 Memorandum that on the twenty day of March anno Domini 1702 her majesty's
 of Justices having issued in these words following

Arrest of England the 20th day of March County of Kent Gaolers Comenry: y^e bigge
 Lawfull men of y^e Bailiwick y^e make knowne unto James Broome if he
 found in y^e Bailiwick hee he shall appeare before y^e Justices of our next Court to be
 held for our said County of fourth Tuesday in June next to show cause if any he
 have why Execution should issue ag^t him for y^e sum of fifty pounds of law
 full money & one hundred Eighty & eight shillings of lawfull money as a judgment
 obtained by y^e Justices of our said Court upon y^e non-suit all a Court held the
 10th day of March anno Domini 1702 fore. our Justices att^r Court of Sessions
 shall not at y^e peril of y^e said James Broome have. Then there this writt of Writ of Habeas
 King Gent Chiefe Justice of our said Court be. Wherof y^e said James Broome
 Endorsed made knowne to y^e me Jo^h: Hawkins there.

And the said James Broome appearing, saith, that he hath no cause to show
 why Execution should not issue as being by the Court heard & understood, It is
 by the Justices ordered that the said writt of Habeas therein be confirmed, as to y^e
 fifty pounds of lawfull money, and the Court of Sessions that y^e said James
 may have an Execution of the said James.

 said Court of Sessions hath granted him y^e writt of Habeas
 as is granted, and y^e Court of Sessions hath committed y^e said
 sufficient Bail, is thereupon committed into y^e Kings
 Custody: Securus Legem.

 Custody: Securus Legem.
