of Kent Count Court now setting his Certaine bill ag George Gumley of Kent County Esq of y last will and Testament of Edward Gray at Dicty Edward Gray of Kent County y holder lately deceased, here pth in Court in his proper person of a plea of he renderd him y sum of fifteen pound seven shillings Money of England which from him he unjustly Detaines

And whereas the pth by his att^{ny} says y whereas y Edward in his life time to wit y tenth Day of April anno Dni 1703 at Kent County wth y Jurisdiction of this Court by his Certaine writing obligatory sealed wth his seal as his att^{ny} had produced & here in Court produced whose Date is y Day and year afo^{re} Did oblige himselfe his heires & adm^{rs} to pay unto the pth Cornelius Comagis his heires & adm^{rs} the sum of fifteen pound seven shillings Money of England on all Demands after y Day of the Date of y^{re} writing obligatory yett notwithstanding the pth Edward Gray in his life time and y afo^{re} George after y Death of y pth Edward Gray altho of law requirad y^{re} 15:17:00 sum money to him the pth Cornelius Comagis have not renderd but y same to him to render have Denied y^{re} afo^{re} George y same to him the pth Cornelius as yett to rend: Both Donij and unjustly
