sufficient Evidence appearing to prosecute any further -

The sd Adam is fined (10<sup>s</sup> of tobacco or 5<sup>s</sup>) for being Drunk and  
is Comitted for sd fine; & Hos -

Ordered that if attys of this Court Doe file their reasons w<sup>th</sup> their  
Demurrer five Dayes before y<sup>e</sup> Court of trial

Ordered by this Court That Charles Rodinsworth Jun<sup>r</sup> Doe keep  
the Ferrij upon Chester River upon his owne proffest & Charge,  
for space of one whole year from Date hereof, and he y<sup>e</sup> sd Charles  
Doe receive paymt for ferrriage for men & horse from all persons  
soe ferried viz six pence for every person & six pence for every horse  
soe ferried as afo<sup>r</sup> (except hereafter excepted) viz all y<sup>e</sup> Justices of  
this County in four times, all Evidences, and y<sup>e</sup> Quens atty at said  
times, & all Jurors (Lawfully summoned) at sd times, for w<sup>th</sup> Exceptions  
The Court allows him y<sup>e</sup> sd Charles for his trouble) y<sup>e</sup> sum of one  
thousand pounds of tobacco, Provided he must ferrij all y<sup>e</sup> County soe  
requesting) at any Election time, if shall happen during y<sup>e</sup> time  
afo<sup>r</sup>; Provided also y<sup>e</sup> if noe person or persons shall come under  
any plea of y<sup>e</sup> Exceptions afo<sup>r</sup>, or if they or he Doe, if then  
it may, & it is hereby Lawfull for y<sup>e</sup> sd Charles to recover of such  
person or persons, Double ferrriage at y<sup>e</sup> rates afo<sup>r</sup> Quincly & ff

Thomas Scottin comes into Court and maketh y<sup>e</sup> has given nine  
Dayes attence, at Court, as Evidence for Charles Floyd ag<sup>t</sup> y<sup>e</sup> sd North  
& thereupon an order is granted him to receive pay for y<sup>e</sup> same  
according to att of asembly

John Meridith comes & gives oath y<sup>e</sup> he has given 4 Dayes attence  
at Court as Evidence for Tho. Godwin ag<sup>t</sup> y<sup>e</sup> sd Langley and thereupon he  
has an order granted him according to att of
