 which was in the years of our Lord 1700 by the grand
 Jury of this County was orderd to be Sumond her by virtue
 of a Writ for which accordingly Shud: but for as much as
 the said Mary absconded and conceald her self so from the sight of the
 Sher that she could not be taken untill this present Court the
 Presentm^t is found into a Bill of indictment which follows in
 these words:

Yent p. The Jurors for our Sovereign Lord the King that now is for
 the body of Kent County upon their oaths do present Mary Onwale
 of Kent County Spinster at out Mary Onwale for y^e the said Mary
 at Eastrook hundred in Kent County within the Jurisdiction of
 this Court the fear of God before her by not having but being on evil
 and wicked mind together with acertaine Thomas Tolley the tenth day
 of November Anno Dom 1700 did and still doth mecontinently
 but and the Company of the said Thomas frequent against the peace
 of our Lord the King and against the form of the Act of Assembly

Whereupon the said Mary, having heard the said Indictment read &
 being demanded whether she was guilty of the indictm^t afo. or not guilty
 and how she should be tryed, says that she is not guilty of y^e premises and for
 by all puts her self upon the Trye:

 Whereupon command is given the Sher of Kent County y^e he immediately
 cause to come here hooloo be a by whom pe. who doth not pe. to recognize
 pe. because aswell pe. And now here the same day to wit the 27th
