 soe if he have his body before the Justice of Kent County shert
 at next Court shew following; at which next Court of Day of the
 return of Court being come the Sher made ret-hereof
 Indorsed Copi (copy) for John Haukerly Sher
 Whereupon the Dollen appeared in his proper person & prayed leave to justify
 the same until next Court; which was granted him; & James Dollen given
 full power, at which next Court the same was continued, & the same
 to Court until this Court Court, and so went Court to wit this 2th Day of
 July anno Dni 1403 some usual of the Dollen in his proper person as if
 by Deed written in his act; who Deed as followeth

 upon himself assumed and unto the Dollen then and there said Duddle
 the ship called Anne should safely arrive at the Port of London if then he the
 Dollen together with the Duddle of the Dollen one kind of tobacco would take up & stow
 & faithfully wout fraud or Deceipt Dispose & sell by best advantage for the Dollen
 up the Duddle of the Dollen according to the Custom of Merchants & factors
 practiced & used in such Cases by next process of the Dollen one kind of tobacco to the Dollen
 would well & truly pay & satisfy, and the Dollen in full satisfaction of the Dollen
 Anne in the year 1400 with the Dollen one kind of tobacco as the Dollen
 Caard of ship freighted safely arrived at the Port of London & the Dollen one kind of
 tobacco to the Dollen of the Dollen safely came yet the Dollen his atty
 promise & assumption like regarding but Deceiving & fraudulently intending
