Except immediately, and sayeth that he hath here read; to wit as by his  
 precept he was comanded to wit: Robert Dunn, Ben Sparkes, George Bewell, Nathl  
 Cave, Denat, Smith, Thos Jackson, John Bishop, Robt Parker, Dicoy Mason  
 Sam Boney, Henry Morgan, Richard Jllingham, who being elected Jurat & sworn  
 to say of truth in y<sup>e</sup> premises Doe say say upon their oath. That we of y<sup>e</sup>  
 Jurij have no prove of y<sup>e</sup> premises as y<sup>e</sup> Do sent, we say he is not guilty  
 of y<sup>e</sup> premises

Which being by y<sup>e</sup> Court heard & understood he by them considered howe  
 Day to wit this twenty fifth Day of July anno Dom 1703 that y<sup>e</sup> Court  
 take nothing by his writs but bin more for his plea than it is to  
 y<sup>e</sup> writ of y<sup>e</sup> Court goe thro' w<sup>th</sup> out Day, and it is likewise ordered  
 by y<sup>e</sup> Court y<sup>e</sup> Day of y<sup>e</sup> 29<sup>th</sup> of June December over a shillings  
 worth as w<sup>th</sup> y<sup>e</sup> sum of fifty pounds of tobacco for excise owing to  
 w<sup>th</sup> of a penalty, as y<sup>e</sup> sum of two hundred fifty & eight pounds of tobacco  
 for his Cost & Charges laid out & Expended according to y<sup>e</sup> form of the Statute
