John Sutton, having been Complaind of for unreasonably dealing his  
Servant, was ordered to give Security for his appearance here next Cell  
Whereupon comes the said John, and acknowledgeth himself to be Justly  
indebted to his Saied Majesty King W<sup>m</sup> the third of England be. in the  
full and just sum of ten pounds for money of England. Likewise comes into Cell  
Morgan Brown and W<sup>m</sup> Jones and acknowledg themselves to be  
severally indebted unto his afo<sup>d</sup> Majesty in the sum of five pounds  
for each. The said severall sumes to be payed on their and each of their  
goods or Chattells Lands or tenements to the use of his said Majesty his heirs  
Successors in case the above mentioned John Sutton do not make his Per-  
sonall appearance at the next Cell to be holden for this County; and then  
and whatsoever the said Court shall be holden, Answer the said and likewise  
produce to the Cell the Servant so by him Dealt, who now complain.

The same Day comes into Court *Mr. Elias King* High Sher of  
this County and adjourns this Court, and likewise continues all procces  
until the first Tuesday of April next By Proclamation according  
to an Act of Assembly Entituled an Act for the Relief of Kent  
and Salvoit Counties in this case specially provided. Whereupon
