It is therefore considered here by the Court this 25th Day of March anno Domini 1401 that the said Charles recover of the said Edward as well of principal as of interest the sum of one hundred eighty & eight pounds of lawfull Debt due to the said Charles in mercantile

Went Charles Hollinsworth by Richard Marklin his attorney complains of Edward Bonwick Gent one of the Justices of the Peace for the County of Kent here present in Court in his possession of a plea of trespass upon the said Charles for a sum of four hundred seven shillings and four pence of value of cattle & goods due to the said Charles for services accommodations, as appears by Deeds and Receipts filed in this Court by Richard Marklin attorney for the said Charles

And now here this Day to wit this 25th Day of March anno Domini 1401 the said Charles being here in Court in his proper person but can not being in Court of plea in his own name, & hereupon Judge is awarded by this Court for the balance of the said Debt & cost of suit

It is therefore considered here by the Court this 25th Day of March anno Domini 1401 that the said Charles recover of the said Edward as well of principal as of interest the sum of four hundred seven shillings & four pence of value of cattle & goods & one hundred eighty & eight pounds of lawfull Debt & cost of suit.

Went John Hannin by Richard Moore at the Diet Richard Moore of West County Kent was summoned to answer unto the said John Hannin of a plea of the said Richard Moore full & just sum of one hundred & five hundred pounds of good & lawfull merchantable leasehold in the County of Kent to him due & owing from the said Richard Moore as by a Deed filed in this Court by Richard Marklin of the said John Hannin attorney appears

And now here this Day to wit this 25th Day of March anno Domini 1401 the said John Hannin by his attorney prays that the said Richard Moore may appear & answer to the said action but the said Richard Moore doth not appear neither by himself nor his attorney but maketh Default upon which Judge is awarded by the Court for the said Debt & cost of suit

It is therefore considered here by the Court this 25th Day of March anno Domini 1401 that the said John Hannin recover of the said Richard Moore as well of principal as of interest the sum of one hundred & five hundred pounds of lawfull Debt & cost of suit

Went Geo: Lumley by Peter Reed at the Diet Peter Reed of West County Kent was summoned to answer unto Geo: Lumley of a plea of the said Geo: Lumley full & just sum of 300 pounds of good & lawfull merchantable leasehold in the County of Kent to him due & owing from the said Geo: Lumley as appears by a Deed & bill filed in this Court in due form & whereupon the said Peter Reed not appearing neither by himself nor his attorney according to the rules of this Court the said Geo: Lumley prays Judge that which is granted unto him

It is therefore considered here by the Court this 25th Day of March 1401 that the said Geo: Lumley recover of the said Peter Reed as well of principal as of interest the sum of 300 pounds of lawfull Debt & cost of suit
