It is therefore considered here by the Court the Day & year aforesaid of the
 20th day of March as well of quantity of three barrells of powder
 the Debt as of sum of two hundred sixty & five pence of tobacco cost
 of suit & of the Defendant in sum of 200 65

 The beasts as aforesaid to be proper beasts of the Edmond in Daniel & of
 Right to him to belong & appertaining craftily & subtilly to Detaine and
 Deceave the Defendant to the Edmond nor to the Solomon Guardian
