John Rich's pet.
The Petition of John Rich wherein he prays & Maintains from
County road and ordered thereupon that Thomas Scottin of Kent County
find the said pet. with competent dwelling and other accommodations
viz. meat Drink Washing and Lodging for his space of one whole
year next ensuing, and that the said Thomas Scottin be charged there-
fore by the County at the expiration of this time with a sum of twelve
hundred pounds of Tobacco

Francis Finck's pet.
The Petition of Francis Finck read as follows viz.
To the Worshipful Justice of Kent County in Court sitting, The pet. of Francis
Finck. Sheweth That the said pet. being appointed one of the Justices in the
Will of Francis Finck's decd and there being above thousand and odd
pounds of Tobacco due out of his decd estate to Samuel son of said
Francis and left in the hands of John Trow who married the Mother
of said Samuel.

The said pet. prays that this Court would well enquire into the same
and take Security for the said sum from the said Trow's hands the
same shall be found. And the said pet. shall pray

Which said pet. being read It appeared to this Court that the said sum was
due in the hands of John Trow, whereupon ordered that the said Trow
appear at the next Court to be held for the said County and there
make answer unto such things as shall be required of him concerning the same

Ordered that Lambert Wilmer have a warrant directed to him
to clear a Road of narrow way from Wilmer's Mill into Cecil road
which was accordingly done

Ordered that Abraham Ambrose be appointed Constable in the Road
and place of Geo. Lumley for the ensuing year who was accordingly
sworn thereto

Ordered that the rates of Liquors & the same for the ensuing year
as they were for the preceding year
