full and just sum of one thousand seven hundred sixty and nine pounds
of Tobacco qualified as a^{ft} to be paid to y^e sd Richard his Ex^r adm^r or assigny
upon y^e tenth Day of October then next ensuing y^e Date of y^e same bill
convenient on his y^e sd Thomas then Dooding plantation to y^e sd Richard in full
and truly to be made and Done y^e sd Thomas bound himselfe his heirs
& Ex^r and adm^r in y^e personal sum of 3430^o of Tobacco qualified as a^{ft} to be
paid as a^{ft} yett notwithstanding which the said y^e sd sum 1769 of Tobacco
according to y^e form and end effect of y^e same bill unto y^e sd Richard he
hath not paid although often Demanded whereby action hath accrued
to y^e sd Richard to require and have from y^e said Thomas y^e said sum of
3430^o of Tobacco but y^e same to pay he hath Denied and refused and still doth
Deny & refuse (although often required) and unjustly Detains to y^e Damage
of y^e sd Richard 7075^o of Tobacco and thereupon he bring this suit
