 Due to Elias King Gent when heigh Sheriff of West County
 Leav^{ing} Due in 1699: 1700: & 1701 and two hundred & Sixty six
 of t^o Cost of Suit herof to be not be^{ing} and have y^e shew there
 this writ of Habeas Corpus Elias King Gent Chief Justice of our s^{aid}
 Court this 26th day of Aug^{ust} in y^e third year of our Reigne Anno

 att this Court to answer unto Robert Grundy of a plea if he can
 unto him of full & just sum of Six hundred twenty and four
 pounds of t^o & Cost
 And now here this Day to wit this 26th Day of Aug^{ust} anno Dni
 1704 Comy Day of y^e retr of y^e writ of y^e Sheriff makes retr
 hereof Entered Cap^{it} Corpus J^ohn Hawkins Sheriff
 & hereupon y^e Doct^r Coner in his prope^r person and saith
 that he cannot gainsay y^e writ in his own o^{wn} face as yet
 brought and is therefore willing y^e Judge Conyate him y^e
 Debt of t^o and Cost of Suit

Which being by y^e Court heard It is by y^e Justices here ordered
 that y^e Doct^r Grundy recover ag^{ainst} y^e Andrew Canard as well
 the sum of Six hundred twenty and four pounds of t^o as
 the sum of one hundred ninety & nine pounds of t^o Cost of
 Suit and the Doct^r J^ohn Mery: Dⁿ
