Thomas Donney being fined by this Court for not appearing as Grandjurij man) She doth appear and submitts to y^e Court, and thereupon y^e Court remittes him by this Court

Walter Baconell and Eliz^a North are sworn and sent to y^e Grandjurij

The Court giveth Judgment of James Countizes to pay Thomas Jacobson two hundred pounds of Tobacco for a serv^t.

Ordered by this Court of a sine fine to be given ag^t Mary Ponder widow, to app^{ear} at next Court to show cause (if any she have) why execution should not issue out ag^t her for her son^s fees she doth first bring evidence in behalfe of y^e Queen

Ordered by this Court if y^e sh^{er} Doe have an execution for his staffs fees ag^t Jⁿ Parson Jun^r, provided y^e sh^{er} proves his act

William Boulton being fined for the y^e fine, is by this Court remittes

Mary Ponder appears, as bound & recogⁿ, and is thereupon Discharged

Ordered by this Court, that Jⁿ Hawkins high sh^{er} of this County Doe take Elizabeth Durrett into his custody, and y^e Elizabeth in his Custody, until he can sell or dispose of her, for her fees the sh^{er} is hereby accountable

Ordered by this Court, if Richard Moores fine be remittes

Thomas Mountsijer appears to this Court as bound & recogⁿ, and is thereupon ordered to finde security againe, for his appearance at next Court

The said Thomas comes into Court and acknowledgeth himselfe to be bound, and finelj; bound unto her Sacred Majesty Queen Anne of England &c in y^e sum of ten pounds, &c likewise comes into Court John Nicholson and Jⁿ Hollisworth and acknowledgeth themselves to be severally indebted as above to y^e sum of five pounds ster each

They severall summs to be levied respectively of their and every of their good and Chattels Lands and tenaments, to and for use of her Majesty her heirs and success^{ors} if in case y^e above bounden Thomas Mountsijer Doe not make his personall appearance at next County Court to be holden for this County and there to abide &c And in y^e maine be of good Behavior and a peace &c
