Dues to be paid as directed in the words of the Court. John Offley

Edward Sampson is bound (at this Court) to Mr Paul Jones, until the 3d Edward comes att of age, of twenty one years, and if Paul is hereby obliged to learn him to be a Carpenter

James Haywood being sett free from his master William Baileman (as before rehearsed) since the 20th and 21st of the last year, and it is ordered by this Court that his said master Doe pay him his freedom Dues according to Act of Assembly, as also of the 1st of William, Doe pay unto him (James) five hundred pounds of tobacco for the time his master kept him after being free by the Court
