 therefore considered here by y^e Justices this twentieth Day
 of March Anno Dni 1705 That y^e said John Hart recover
 against y^e said Charles Hollinsworth a w^ol^d of y^e sum of three pounds
 nine shillings and two pence halfe penny The Debt specified as
 as a p^lff^r as y^e sum of two hundred twenty and one pounds of
 of tobacco Cost of Suit and the Doct^r in mercy &c.

Elias Taylor p^lff^r in three Acc^ons upon this Com^o Jac^o w^{ch} was committed for
 want of Baile. But Michael Carke Attorney for said p^lff^r says
 upon his selfe to discontinue the said three Acc^ons, upon the p^lff^r
 y^e Doct^r & the Court in open Court to w^{ch} the said Carke or
 his att^ony, unless the said Debt & Cost were fully paid, sum^o &c.
