good sound Merchantable leaf tob. which to him he owes
and from him he unjustly detaineth. of which said writt of
the Sheriff made return that he had taken the body and served
the Copy accordingly. Whereupon the Plaintiff by his Attorney
Prays that the said Benja. Def. may into his debt Insue
which was granted, but for as much as it appears to this Court
that the said Defend. by himself or his Attly hath not
filed his plea thereto according to the rules of this Court

It is by them considered this seventh day of Aprile
Anno Dom 1702 that the said Edward recover against the
Benjamin as well the sum of nine hundred forty two
pounds of tobacco the debt as the sum of
two hundred and thirty one pounds of tob. Est. of Suit and the
Defend. in Morey &c.

for the sum of five hundred pounds of tobacco
as by the declaration filed in this Court May at large Appare
and the said writt having been served with a Copy of the
said declaration annex in order for Justice this Court
the Plaintiff by his Attorney Appares and in prosecution
of the Action and Prays Judg. for his debt and Est. of Suit
for that the said Defend. hath not filed his plea according
to the debt and according to the rules of this Court in such
Cases provided. which being by the Justice here enquired
of and found to be true It is by them considered according
to the prayer of the Plaintiff this seventh day of Aprile
Anno Dom 1702 that the said Thomas Hyndley recover ag.
the said Wm Wiggon as well the sum of five hundred pounds
of tob. debt as the sum of three hundred and fifty and nine
pounds of tobacco Est. of Suit and the Def. in Morey &c.
