 Anno Dni 1705 and Divers times as well before as since hath and Doth Challenged  
 Incontinently w<sup>th</sup> Margret Smith widow and relict of James Smith late of this  
 County Deceased / altho' Legally admonished to y<sup>e</sup> contrary as y<sup>e</sup> Law Directs in such  
 Cases to y<sup>e</sup> Great Scandall of Christian Religion and contrary to a certaine  
 Act of assembly in y<sup>e</sup> Case made and proved  
 Elizabeth Regina

Which said bill of Indictm<sup>t</sup> was Indorsed w<sup>th</sup> these words viz  
 Billa vera William Stewart foreman  
 And y<sup>e</sup> sd Charles being bound by recogn<sup>s</sup> to appear at this Court and now  
 appears and being asked what he says to y<sup>e</sup> sd Indictm<sup>t</sup>, He saith y<sup>e</sup> he sub-  
 -mits to y<sup>e</sup> Court, Whereupon the Court orders y<sup>e</sup> sd Charles to pay this 20<sup>th</sup> day  
 of Aug<sup>t</sup> Anno Dni 1705 y<sup>e</sup> fine according to Law for committing  
 Woullery and to pay all fees dueing by reason of these p<sup>r</sup>misses,  
 And the sd Charles is also ord<sup>d</sup> to find security for his good behav<sup>r</sup>  
 at next, and y<sup>e</sup> sd Charles here in Court acknowledges himselfe to be holden  
 and firmly bound unto her sacred majestie Queen Anne of England in  
 the just and full sum of four pounds ster<sup>l</sup>.

Likewise comes into Court William Sigley and Peter Green who  
 acknowledge to be Indorsed as above in y<sup>e</sup> sum of five pounds ster<sup>l</sup>  
 each their said severall sums to be levied respectively of their  
 and every of their Good and Chattels, Lands and tenent<sup>s</sup> y<sup>e</sup> y<sup>e</sup> use  
 of her sd majestie heirs and success<sup>rs</sup>. If y<sup>e</sup> above bounden  
 Charles Hollinsworth Doe not make his personal appearance at  
 next Court to be hold for this County of West and there to ans-  
 -wer, &c and in y<sup>e</sup> mean time be of good behav<sup>r</sup> and  
 abber &c
