say the truth in the Premises and having heard the pleadings  
and Allegations on both sides do say upon their Oaths  
that of the Jury find for the Plaintiff two hundred and six  
pounds of tobacco Damages and Cost of Suit

considered by the Justices this seventh day of April  
that the said Wm Fylliard recover of the said John Toas  
and as of the sum of two hundred and six pounds of tobacco  
Doll for Damages and the sum of three hundred and  
eleven ~~of~~ ~~to~~ pounds of tobacco Cost of Suit etc.
