in the most solemn manner this County was capable of

proclamation was proclaimed Anne Queen of England
By the Grace of God Queen of England Scotland France
and Ireland Defender of the faith, Supreme Lady of the Province
and Plantation of Maryland and all other his late Majesty's
Territories and Dominions in America &c. With loud accla-
:mations of Joy, firing the small arms three times, and complying
With his Majesty's Command as afo.
