From which I next Court went the 23rd day of June 1702 and this cause was sent by the Court unto y^e Next Court at which I next Courted on this twenty fifth day of August 1702. Comed as well the Plaintiff by his Attorney as the Defendant by his Attorney who further defend the Cause and in my opinion and for plea both true it is that y^e Defendant in his life time did recover the said Judge of the Plaintiff debt mentioned for the sum of three thousand four hundred twenty seven pounds of Tobacco; But since the said Recovery the said Defendant by protestation saith that he hath paid and satisfied upon y^e Account of the said Judge the full sum of three thousand six hundred sixty four pounds of Tob^o: as by an account herunto annexed and therein first produced appears all which he is ready to aver and therefore prays discount according to act of Assembly &c. &c.

And it is likewise considered by the Court the same day and year ago that the said Anthony Richardson recover ag^t the said Marg^o Pemberton the sum of three hundred and twenty one pounds of tobacco by the Court adjudged him for his Costs and Charges in this behalf laid out and expended according to the form of the Statute &c.
