AN ACT concerning

Architectural Registration Board - Examination
Fees

FOR the purpose of allowing the Architectural Registration Board to set fees to cover the costs of examination for an applicant for registration as an architect.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article 43 - Health

523.

(A) The Board shall promulgate from time to time a reasonable schedule of fees and charges for its services. Such fees and charges may be less than, but shall not exceed, the amounts indicated for the services listed below:

- [1. Original examination -- \$75.00
2. Retake examination -- \$75.00]
- [3.] 1. Issuance of registration -- \$60.00
- [4.] 2. Annual renewal of license -- \$35.00

[5.] 3. Additional late charge for renewal of licenses issued more than thirty days after due date for renewal has expired -- \$50.00
