SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1981.

CHAPTER 117

(Senate Bill 527)

AN ACT concerning

Inspection of Used Vehicles - Definition of Vehicle

FOR the purpose of providing that certain classes of vehicles are subject to the motor vehicle inspection laws.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article - Transportation
Section 23-101(h)
Annotated Code of Maryland
(1977 Volume and 1980 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article - Transportation

23-101.

(h) (1) "Vehicle" means, except as otherwise provided in this subsection, any vehicle registered or to be registered in this State as:

- (i) A Class A (passenger) vehicle;
- (ii) A Class M (multipurpose) vehicle;
- (iii) A Class J (van pool) vehicle;
- (iv) A Class E (truck) vehicle;
- (v) A Class F (tractor) vehicle; [or]
- (vi) A Class G (trailer) vehicle[.];
