- (b) In addition to the duties set forth elsewhere in this title, the Board shall:
- (1) Keep a list of the name and address of each licensed physical therapist and licensed physical therapist assistant; [and]
- (2) Present evidence of any alleged violation of this title to the State's attorney of the county where the alleged violation occurred; AND
- (3) ADOPT RULES AND REGULATIONS THAT GOVERN THE USE OF A PHYSICAL THERAPY AIDE BY A LICENSED PHYSICAL THERAPIST.

13-301.

- (a) Except as otherwise provided in this title, an individual shall be licensed by the Board before the individual may practice physical therapy or limited physical therapy in this State.
 - (b) This section does not apply to:
- (1) A student who is supervised directly by a licensed physical therapist in a Board approved physical therapy educational er-elimieal program; [and] OR
- (2) [An] A PHYSICAL THERAPY aide, IF THE PHYSICAL THERAPY AIDE:
- (I) SUBJECT TO THE RULES AND REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE BOARD, LERFORMS ONLY PROCEDURES THAT DO NOT REQUIRE THE PROFESSIONAL SKILLS OF A LICENSED PHYSICAL THERAPIST OR A LICENSED PHYSICAL THERAPIST ASSISTANT; AND
- (II) [who is supervised directly by] PERFORMS PROCEDURES ONLY UNDER THE DIRECT SUPERVISION OF a licensed physical therapist WHO PERSONALLY IS PRESENT IN THE AREA WHERE THE PROCEDURES ARE PERFORMED.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1981.
