CHAPTER 135

(Senate Bill 1000)

AN ACT concerning

Unemployment Insurance - Extended Benefits

FOR the purpose of limiting the payment of extended benefits under certain circumstances when a claimant files claims: interstate restricting, under certain circumstances, eligibility for extended benefits if an individual has been subject to benefits; providing disqualifications for regular certain disqualifications for extended benefits if an individual fails to actively engage in seeking work, to accept an offer of suitable work, or to apply for suitable work; and requiring, with certain exceptions, that an individual applying for extended benefits be referred to suitable work; clarifying the effect of provisions relating to regular benefits on claims for, the payment of, extended benefits; generally relating to extended benefits; and making this Act an emergency measure.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:
