

having psittacosis or found or harbored on the same premises where infection with OF psittacosis virus is discovered or suspected, shall be immediately destroyed, under such rules and regulations as the State Board of Health SECRETARY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE may pass ESTABLISH to carry out the purposes of this section. EXCEPTIONS MAY BE MADE BY THE SECRETARY OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE. Any person violating any of the provisions of this section, or any order or regulation of the State Board of Health SECRETARY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE lawfully made pursuant thereto, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be subject to a fine of not more than fifty dollars (\$50.00) \$1,000 for each offense. }

### Article --- Agriculture

3-104-1-

(A) --- IN THIS SECTION, "EXOTIC BIRD" MEANS AN AVIAN SPECIES THAT IS NOT NATIVE TO THE UNITED STATES.

(B) --- A PERSON SHALL KEEP A RECORD COVERING ANY EXOTIC BIRD RECEIVED OR DISPOSED OF BY THAT PERSON OR AGENT OF THAT PERSON. THIS RECORD SHALL INCLUDE:

(1) --- AT THE TIME A BIRD IS RECEIVED,

(i) --- THE BIRD'S SPECIES,

(ii) --- THE DATE OF RECEIPT, AND

(iii) --- THE NAME AND ADDRESS OF THE FORMER OWNER OR POSSESSOR,

(2) --- AT THE TIME A BIRD IS DISPOSED OF,

(i) --- THE BIRD'S SPECIES,

(ii) --- THE DATE OF DISPOSAL, AND

(iii) --- THE NAME AND ADDRESS OF THE NEW OWNER OR POSSESSOR.

(C) --- A RECORD REQUIRED UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE KEPT FOR AT LEAST 1 YEAR. ON REQUEST OF THE SECRETARY, AN EXOTIC BIRD KEEPER SHALL GIVE THE RECORD TO THE SECRETARY.

(D) --- IF EXOTIC BIRD DEATHS EXCEED 10 PERCENT OF THE TOTAL NUMBER OF BIRDS ON THE PREMISES OR OF A SINGLE BIRD SHIPMENT, AN EXOTIC BIRD KEEPER SHALL IMMEDIATELY NOTIFY THE SECRETARY. AFTER NOTIFYING THE SECRETARY, AN EXOTIC BIRD KEEPER SHALL:

(1) --- FREEZE EACH DEAD EXOTIC BIRD, AND

(2) --- MAKE THE FROZEN EXOTIC BIRDS AVAILABLE TO THE DEPARTMENT FOR TESTING.
