

(I) THE BIRD'S SPECIES;

(II) THE DATE OF RECEIPT AND THE NUMBER RECEIVED;

(III) THE NAME AND ADDRESS OF THE FORMER OWNER OR POSSESSOR; AND

(2) AT THE TIME A BIRD IS TRANSFERRED;

(I) THE BIRD'S SPECIES;

(II) THE DATE OF TRANSFER; AND

(III) THE NAME AND ADDRESS OF THE NEW OWNER OR POSSESSOR.

(F) A RECORD REQUIRED UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE RETAINED AT EACH PERMIT HOLDER'S FACILITY FOR 1 YEAR.

(G) ALL BIRDS THAT DIE WHILE IN THE CUSTODY OF THE PERMIT HOLDER SHALL BE IMMEDIATELY FROZEN.

(H) THE SECRETARY OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE SHALL PRESCRIBE THE HANDLING, TREATMENT, AND DESTRUCTION OF:

(1) ALL BIRDS SUSPECTED OF HAVING PSITTACOSIS OR DISEASES CONTAGIOUS TO HUMANS;

(2) ALL BIRDS WHICH HAVE BEEN FOUND TO HAVE PSITTACOSIS OR ANY DISEASE CONTAGIOUS TO HUMANS;

(3) ALL BIRDS SUSPECTED OF BEING CARRIERS OF PSITTACOSIS OR ANY DISEASE CONTAGIOUS TO HUMANS;

(4) ALL BIRDS THAT DIE WHILE IN THE CUSTODY OF A PERMIT HOLDER;

(5) ALL BIRDS EXPOSED TO PSITTACOSIS OR ANY DISEASE CONTAGIOUS TO HUMANS; AND

(6) ALL BIRDS FOUND TO BE HARBORED ON THE SAME PREMISES WHERE PSITTACOSIS OR ANY DISEASE CONTAGIOUS TO HUMANS IS DISCOVERED OR SUSPECTED.

(I) THE SECRETARY OF AGRICULTURE SHALL PRESCRIBE THE TREATMENT, HANDLING, AND DESTRUCTION OF:

(1) ALL BIRDS SUSPECTED OF HAVING VELOGENIC VISERTROPHIC NEWCASTLE DISEASE OR OTHER DISEASES CONTAGIOUS TO DOMESTIC ANIMALS OR POULTRY;

(2) ALL BIRDS WHICH HAVE BEEN FOUND TO HAVE VELOGENIC VISERTROPHIC NEWCASTLE DISEASE OR OTHER DISEASES CONTAGIOUS TO DOMESTIC ANIMALS OR POULTRY;
