

(3) ALL BIRDS SUSPECTED OF BEING CARRIERS OF VELOGENIC VISERTROPHIC NEWCASTLE DISEASE OR OTHER DISEASES CONTAGIOUS TO DOMESTIC ANIMALS OR POULTRY;

(4) ALL BIRDS EXPOSED TO VELOGENIC VISERTROPHIC NEWCASTLE DISEASE OR OTHER DISEASES CONTAGIOUS TO DOMESTIC ANIMALS OR POULTRY; AND

(5) ALL BIRDS FOUND TO BE HARBORED ON THE SAME PREMISES WHERE VELOGENIC VISERTROPHIC NEWCASTLE DISEASE OR ANY OTHER DISEASE CONTAGIOUS TO DOMESTIC ANIMALS OR POULTRY IS DISCOVERED OR SUSPECTED.

(J) UPON REQUEST, THE SECRETARY OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE OR A PERMIT HOLDER SHALL MAKE AVAILABLE TO THE SECRETARY OF AGRICULTURE ALL RECORDS, SPECIMENS, AND OTHER MATERIAL NECESSARY TO DIAGNOSE OR TRACE ANY INFECTIOUS DISEASE TRANSMITTABLE TO DOMESTIC ANIMALS OR POULTRY.

(K) ANY PERSON WHO VIOLATES ANY PROVISION OF THIS SECTION, OR ANY ORDER OR REGULATION PURSUANT TO IT ISSUED BY THE SECRETARY OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE OR THE SECRETARY OF AGRICULTURE, IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION, IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000 FOR EACH OFFENSE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1981.

CHAPTER 155

(House Bill 359)

AN ACT concerning

Anne Arundel County - Alcoholic Beverages
(Class D Beer, Wine and Liquor)

FOR the purpose of providing for certain Class D beer, wine and liquor licenses in Anne Arundel County; permitting the Board of License Commissioners to limit the sale of certain alcoholic beverages; and specifying the annual license fee for Class D licenses in Anne Arundel County.
