Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages Section 21(c) Annotated Code of Maryland (1976 Replacement Volume and 1980 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

- [(c) In Anne Arundel County the annual license fee
 therefor shall be nine hundred dollars (\$900.00).]
- (C) (1) IN ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY THERE ARE TWO TYPE CLASS D BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSES:
- (I) A LIMITED CLASS D LICENSE WHICH ALLOWS FOR ON PREMISES CONSUMPTION ONLY.
- (II) A CLASS D LICENSE WHICH ALLOWS FOR CONSUMPTION ON PREMISES OR ELSEWHERE.
- (2) THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS OF ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY, UPON THE FILING OF AN APPLICATION FOR ANY NEW CLASS D BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSE, MAY LIMIT THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES TO CONSUMPTION ONLY ON THE PREMISES.
- (3) (I) THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE FOR A LIMITED CLASS D LICENSE IS \$900.
- (II) THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE FOR A CLASS D ON AND OFF SALE LICENSE IS \$1,100.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1981.

CHAPTER 156

(House Bill 367)

AN ACT concerning
