(House Bill 443)

AN ACT concerning

The Department of Natural Resources - Powers and Duties of the Secretary of Natural Resources

FOR the purpose of <u>deleting reference</u> to the Fisheries <u>Administration</u>; providing expressly that the Secretary is authorized to exercise all powers, duties, of certain newly organized units of the Department in addition to his authority over certain existing units; repealing certain references to units of the Department that are now organized within other units.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:
