

2. Has completed a graduate program accepted by the Board in a behavioral science that includes 1,000 hours of supervised clinical psychotherapy experience; or

(ii) 1. Has a baccalaureate degree from an accredited college or university; and

2. Has 4,000 hours of supervised clinical experience that is approved by the Board.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1981.

CHAPTER 184

(House Bill 951)

AN ACT concerning

Mortuary Science - Pre-need Contracts

FOR the purpose of allowing licensed funeral directors and holders of a surviving spouse license to offer a pre-need contract; and amending a prohibition concerning who may offer a pre-need contract.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland (as enacted by Chapter _____ (H.B. 1) of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1981) be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article - Health Occupations

6-404.

(b) Only a licensed mortician, A LICENSED FUNERAL DIRECTOR, OR A HOLDER OF A SURVIVING SPOUSE LICENSE may offer or agree, directly or indirectly, to provide services or merchandise under a pre-need contract.
