

The Public Local Laws of Queen Anne's County
Section 5-10
Article 18 - Public Local Laws of Maryland
(1974 Edition, as amended)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article 18 - Queen Anne's County

5-10.

Before entering upon the duties of said respective offices, the Clerk and Deputy Clerk shall [make a declaration of religious belief and] take and subscribe the oath set forth in Article I, Section 6 of the Constitution of Maryland before the County Commissioner designated as President and the same shall be recorded in the minutes of the proceedings of the County Commissioners.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1981.
