

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

158.

(i) (1) In Montgomery County, the services of the department of inspection and licenses, the office of the county attorney and other county departments shall be made available to the board. The director of the department of [inspection and licenses] HEALTH OR HIS DESIGNEE shall act ex officio as secretary to the board and [shall] MAY NOT receive [no] extra compensation for [such] THE services.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1981.
