

There are five County Commissioners for Calvert County. The annual salary of the president of the Board is [\$12,500] ~~\$17,000~~ \$18,000, and the annual salary of each of the associate members of the Board is [\$10,000] \$15,000.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act may not be construed to extend or apply to the salary of the county commissioners, treasurer, sheriff, State's Attorney, and members and chairman of the Board of License Commissioners of Calvert County in office on the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary of the county commissioners, treasurer, sheriff, State's Attorney, and the members and chairman of the Board of License Commissioners of Calvert County shall take effect at the beginning of the next following term of office. The provisions of this section do not apply to jurors ~~or--the--members--and--chairman--of--the--Board--of--Education.~~

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1981.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:
