- (1) ON MONDAY, TUESDAY, WEDNESDAY, AND THURSDAY SALES ARE PERMITTED FROM 9 A.M. TO 1 A.M. ON THE FOLLOWING DAY;
- (2) ON FRIDAY AND SATURDAY, SALES ARE PERMITTED FROM 9 A.M. TO 2 A.M. ON THE FOLLOWING DAY;
- (3) ON SUNDAY, SALES ARE PERMITTED FROM 11 A.M. TO 1 A.M. ON THE FOLLOWING DAY; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THAT SALES ARE PERMITTED UNTIL 2 A.M. ON THE FOLLOWING DAY WHEN THE FOLLOWING DAY (MONDAY) HAS BEEN DESIGNATED BY THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT AS ONE OF THE FOLLOWING HOLIDAYS: WASHINGTON'S BIRTHDAY, MEMORIAL DAY, INDEPENDENCE DAY, LABOR DAY, VETERANS DAY AND CHRISTMAS.
  - SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1981.

(House Bill 1724)
