(C) MEMBERS APPOINTED BY GOVERNOR -- TENURE;
VACANCIES.

(1) THE TERM OF A MEMBER APPOINTED BY THE
GOVERNOR IS 4 YEARS.

(2) THE TERMS OF MEMBERS ~~APPOINTED--BY--THE~~
~~GOVERNOR--ON--JULY--1,--1981--ARE--STAGGERED--ACCORDING--TO--THE~~
~~FOLLOWING--EXPIRATION--DATES~~ ARE STAGGERED AS REQUIRED BY THE
