21-301. LICENSING REQUIRED.

EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS TITLE, A PERSON SHALL BE LICENSED BY THE BOARD BEFORE THE PERSON MAY PRACTICE WELL DRILLING IN THIS STATE.

21-302. QUALIFICATIONS OF APPLICANTS.

(A) IN GENERAL.

THE BOARD SHALL ADOPT RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE QUALIFICATIONS OF APPLICANTS.

(B) REQUIREMENTS.

EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS TITLE, TO QUALIFY FOR A LICENSE, AN APPLICANT SHALL MEET ANY REASONABLE QUALIFICATIONS OR REQUIREMENTS THAT THE BOARD ESTABLISHES FOR LICENSE APPLICANTS.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from the general rulemaking authority of the Board in the second sentence of NR § 8-607(d), and the second sentence and the first clause of the third sentence of NR § 8-610(a).

21-303. APPLICATIONS FOR LICENSES.

TO APPLY FOR A LICENSE, AN APPLICANT SHALL:

(1) SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE BOARD ON THE FORM THAT THE BOARD REQUIRES; AND
