

The second sentence of present NR § 8-612, which requires a nonresident applicant to comply with the licensing provisions of this title if there is no reciprocal agreement, is deleted as unnecessary.

21-306. ISSUANCE; CONTENTS; CATEGORIES OF LICENSE; FEES.

(A) ISSUANCE.

THE BOARD SHALL ISSUE AN APPROPRIATE LICENSE TO ANY APPLICANT WHO:

- (1) MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS TITLE;
- (2) PAYS THE REQUIRED FEE; AND
- (3) PROVIDES EVIDENCE OF ANY PERFORMANCE BOND AND CONTRACTOR'S LIABILITY INSURANCE THAT THE BOARD MAY REQUIRE.

(B) CLASSES OF LICENSE; DESIGNATIONS.

(1) IN ACCORDANCE WITH ITS RULES AND REGULATIONS, THE BOARD MAY ISSUE DIFFERENT CLASSES OF LICENSES TO PRACTICE WELL DRILLING.

(2) THE BOARD SHALL INCLUDE ON EACH LICENSE THAT IT ISSUES A DESIGNATION OF THE CLASS OF LICENSE.

(3) THE CLASSES OF LICENSES TO PRACTICE WELL DRILLING INCLUDE:

- (I) A MASTER WELL DRILLER LICENSE;
- (II) A JOURNEYMAN WELL DRILLER LICENSE;
- (III) AN APPRENTICE WELL DRILLER LICENSE;
- (IV) ANY RESTRICTED LICENSE.

(C) FEES.
