21-309. TEMPORARY LICENSE.

(A) IN GENERAL.

IN ACCORDANCE WITH ITS RULES AND REGULATIONS, THE BOARD MAY ISSUE A TEMPORARY LICENSE IN ANY LICENSE CLASS.

(B) APPLICATION.

TO APPLY FOR A TEMPORARY LICENSE, AN APPLICANT SHALL MEET THE REQUIREMENTS OF § 21-303 OF THIS SUBTITLE.

(C) REQUIREMENTS.

EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS TITLE, TO QUALIFY FOR A TEMPORARY LICENSE, AN APPLICANT SHALL MEET ANY REASONABLE QUALIFICATIONS OR REQUIREMENTS THAT THE BOARD ESTABLISHES UNDER THIS SUBTITLE.

(D) ISSUANCE.

THE BOARD SHALL ISSUE AN APPROPRIATE TEMPORARY LICENSE TO ANY APPLICANT WHO:

- (1) MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS TITLE; AND
- (2) PAYS THE REQUIRED FEE.
- (E) TERM.

A TEMPORARY LICENSE EXPIRES AT THE FIRST TO OCCUR OF THE FOLLOWING:

- (1) WHEN THE BOARD ISSUES OR REFUSES TO ISSUE A LICENSE UNDER § 21-306 OF THIS SUBTITLE; OR
- (2) ON THE EXPIRATION DATE THAT THE BOARD DESIGNATES ON THE TEMPORARY LICENSE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from NR § 8-610(c).

In subsection (a) of this section, the term "Board" is substituted for "board secretary" in light of Board practice and because the Board currently does not employ a Board secretary.
