- (3) At the end of a term, a member continues to serve until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
- (4) A member who is appointed after a term has begun serves only for the rest of the term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
- (i) The Governor may remove a member for incompetence or misconduct.]

[11-203.

- (a) From among its members, the Board annually in June shall elect a president, a Board secretary, and a treasurer.
- (b) The manner of election of officers shall be as the Board determines.]

[11-204.

- (a) A majority of the full authorized membership of the Board is a quorum.
 - (b) The Board shall:
- (1) Meet at least once a year, at the times and places that the Board determines and when requested by the Secretary; and
- (2) Notify each Board member of the time and place of each meeting.
- (c) Each member of the Board is entitled to reimbursement for expenses under the Standard State Travel Regulations, as provided in the State budget.
- (d) The Board may employ a staff in accordance with the State budget.]

[11-205.

In addition to the duties set forth elsewhere in this title, the Board shall:

- (1) Keep a book that:
- (i) Lists each licensed doctor of osteopathy; and
- (ii) Is open to public inspection with proper restrictions for its safekeeping;
 - (2) Keep a record of:
 - (i) Each license applicant;
