- (e) Except as otherwise provided in this title, the applicant shall pass an examination given by the Board under this subtitle.
- (f) The Board shall deny an application for a license to an individual who has been convicted of procuring, aiding, or abetting a criminal abortion.]

[11-303.

To apply for a license, an applicant shall:

- (1) Submit an application to the Board on the form that the Board requires; and
- (2) Pay to the Board an application fee of \$25.]
- (a) An applicant who otherwise qualifies for a license is entitled to be examined as provided in this section.
- (b) The Board shall give examinations to applicants at least twice a year, at the times and places that the Board determines.
- (c) The Board shall notify each qualified applicant of the time and place of examination.
- (d) (1) The Board may adopt rules and regulations for giving examinations.
- (2) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, the Board shall determine the subjects, scope, and form for examinations given under this title.
- (3) The examination shall include anatomy, physiology, hygiene, and other health and medical subjects that relate to osteopathy.
- (4) The Board shall give a written examination, but may use supplementary examinations, including oral and clinical examinations.
- (e) (1) The examination may be given by the Board or by a committee of one or more members of the Board that is appointed by the Board.
- (2) If the examination is given by a committee, after the examination, the Committee shall:
 - (i) Act promptly on each examination; and
- (ii) Make and send to the Board an official report signed by each committee member.
