Annotated Code of Maryland (1977 Volume and 1980 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article - Transportation

16-405.

- (a) If the suspension or revocation of a license would affect adversely the employment or opportunity for employment of a licensee, the hearing officer may:
- (1) Decline to order the suspension or revocation; or
- (2) Cancel or modify the suspension or revocation.
- (b) For purposes of \$16-404 of this subtitle, if a licensee is required to drive a motor vehicle in the course of his regular employment:
- (1) [The notice of suspension] SUSPENSION requires 16 points; and
- (2) [The notice of revocation] REVOCATION requires 19 points.
- (C) THE PROVISIONS OF SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION SHALL NOT APPLY TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHO WHOSE CURRENT ACCUMULATION OF POINTS INCLUDES:
- (1)--HAS--ACCUMULATED--LESS--THAN--8--POINTS--AND SUBSEQUENTLY--RECEIVES--ADDITIONAL--POINTS--RESULTING---FROM CONVICTION--FOR--A-VIOLATION-OF-\$-21~902-OF-THIS-ARTICLE;-OR
- (2)--HAS--ACCUMULATED--8--OR--MORE---POINTS---AND SUSPENSION--HAS--NOT-BEEN-IMPOSED-PURSUANT-TO-SUBSECTION-(B) OF-THIS-SECTION--AND--SUBSEQUENTLY--RECEIVES--ADDITIONAL IS ASSESSED POINTS RESULTING FROM A CONVICTION FOR A VIOLATION OF § 21-902 OF THIS ARTICLE.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1981.
