- (2) AN EXAMINATION IS NOT REQUIRED FOR A TEACHER'S LICENSE TO PRACTICE DENTISTRY, A LIMITED LICENSE TO PRACTICE DENTISTRY, OR A TEACHER'S LICENSE TO PRACTICE DENTAL HYGIENE.
- (G) ADDITIONAL QUALIFICATIONS -- TEACHER'S LICENSE TO PRACTICE DENTISTRY.
- IN ADDITION TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTIONS (A), (B), (C), AND (D) OF THIS SECTION, TO QUALIFY FOR A TEACHER'S LICENSE TO PRACTICE DENTISTRY, THE APPLICANT SHALL:
- (1) BE LICENSED TO PRACTICE DENTISTRY IN ANY OTHER STATE;
- (2) HAVE BEEN ACTIVE IN THE DENTAL PROFESSION FOR AT LEAST 5 YEARS;
- (3) BE A FULL-TIME FACULTY MEMBER AT A COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY WHERE THE APPLICANT TEACHES A SUBJECT REQUIRED BY THE DENTAL SCHOOL OF THAT COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY; AND
- (4) IF THE APPLICANT IS ENGAGED IN A TEACHING AREA THAT IS DESIGNATED AS A SPECIALTY BY THE AMERICAN DENTAL ASSOCIATION, MEET THE REQUIREMENTS ESTABLISHED BY THE AMERICAN DENTAL ASSOCIATION FOR THAT SPECIALTY.
- (H) ADDITIONAL QUALIFICATIONS -- TEACHER'S LICENSE TO PRACTICE DENTAL HYGIENE.
- IN ADDITION TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTIONS (A), (B), AND (E) OF THIS SECTION, TO QUALIFY FOR A TEACHER'S LICENSE TO PRACTICE DENTAL HYGIENE, THE APPLICANT SHALL:
- (1) BE LICENSED TO PRACTICE DENTAL HYGIENE IN ANY OTHER STATE;
- (2) HAVE BEEN ACTIVE AS A DENTAL HYGIENIST FOR AT LEAST 5 YEARS BEFORE APPLYING FOR THE TEACHER'S LICENSE TO PRACTICE DENTAL HYGIENE; AND
- (3) BE A FULL-TIME FACULTY MEMBER AT A DENTAL SCHOOL WHERE THE APPLICANT TEACHES A SUBJECT REQUIRED BY THAT SCHOOL.
