4-303. WAIVER OF QUALIFICATIONS -- LICENSE TO PRACTICE DENTISTRY.

(A) IN GENERAL.

SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION, THE BOARD MAY WAIVE THE EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS OF § 4-302 OF THIS SUBTITLE FOR AN APPLICANT WHO IS A GRADUATE OF ANY SCHOOL OF DENTISTRY.

(B) CONDITIONS.

THE BOARD MAY GRANT A WAIVER UNDER THIS SECTION ONLY IF THE APPLICANT:

(1) PASSES A SERIES OF PRELIMINARY TESTS GIVEN BY THE BOARD UNDER ITS RULES AND REGULATIONS TO DETERMINE THAT THE APPLICANT IS QUALIFIED TO TAKE THE EXAMINATION FOR A GENERAL LICENSE TO PRACTICE DENTISTRY; AND

(2) MEETS ANY OTHER REQUIREMENTS THAT THE BOARD ESTABLISHES FOR A WAIVER OF THE EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS OF § 4-302 OF THIS SUBTITLE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from Art. 32, § 5(d).

Subsection (b)(2) of this section is new language added to clarify that the power of the Board to impose requirements for a waiver under this section is not limited to giving tests to determine that an applicant is qualified to take the examination.

4-304. APPLICATIONS FOR LICENSES.

(A) IN GENERAL.

TO APPLY FOR A LICENSE, AN APPLICANT SHALL:

(1) SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE BOARD ON THE FORM THAT THE BOARD REQUIRES; AND
