(4) ANY BALANCE OVER THE AMOUNT REQUIRED FOR THE PAYMENT OF TAXES, INTEREST, PENALTIES, AND COSTS OF SALE SHALL BE PAID BY THE COLLECTOR TO:

(I) THE PERSON ENTITLED TO THE BALANCE, OR

(II) WHEN THERE IS A DISPUTE REGARDING PAYMENT OF THE BALANCE, TO A COURT OF COMPETENT JURISDICTION PENDING A COURT ORDER TO DETERMINE THE PROPER DISTRIBUTION OF THE BALANCE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1981.

CHAPTER 259

(Senate Bill 107)

AN ACT concerning

The Office on Aging

FOR the purpose of directing the Office on Aging to establish a "Golden ~~Oricle~~ Age Card" program to encourage the development of voluntary programs which may extend assistance for disabled persons and persons over a certain age; and providing certain duties for the Director of the Office on Aging.

Article 70B - Office on Aging

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:
