7-6A-04.

(a) All funds received by the Department from license fees, permit fees, SPECIAL RECLAMATION FEES, the forfeiture of bonds and of cash deposits and securities, and fines collected upon conviction of an operator under §§ 7-6A-06[(c)] (E) and 7-6A-07[(f)] (H) shall be deposited to the credit of the State Treasurer in a bank he designates OR MAY-BE-INVESTED-AS-PROVIDED-BY-LAW, and shall be maintained as a special fund on the books of the Comptroller of the Treasury in an account, to be known as the "Surface Mined Land Reclamation Fund." This Fund shall be used by the Department for the administration and implementation of this subtitle, including rehabilitating the area of land affected by the operation upon which liability was charged on the bond.
